




6 November 2021: Arab-Austrian Cultural Season



20 October 2021: The 12th Arab-Austrian Economic Forum" (Online Edition)







The webinar was moderated by AACC Secretary-General Mr. Mouddar Khouja and attended by over 80 participants from all over the world.





On July 1st 2021, the webinar "Adjusting to 'New Normal' in Education and Healthcare sectors in the UAE & Austria" took place, jointly organised by the **Austro-Arab Chamber of Commerce (AACC)** and **Sharjah Chamber of Commerce & Industry (SCCI).** The webinar was attended by over 100 participants, who joined virtually from all over the world.

Welcome notes and opening remarks were delivered by AACC Austrian President H.E. Senator Dr. Richard Schenz, Chairman of Sharjah Chamber of Commerce & Industry H.E. Mr. Abdullah Sultan Al-Oweis and the Ambassador of the United Arab Emirates to Austria H.E. Mr. Ibrahim Al-Musharrakh. Ms. Fatema Khalifa Al-Muqarrab, Director of International Relations Department at Sharjah Chamber of Commerce & Industry, also delivered a presentation on behalf of SCCI.



On 20 April 2021, H.E. Peter Hanke, Executive City Councillor of Finance, Business, Labour, International Affairs, and Vienna Public Utilities, received H.E. Ibrahim Almusharrakh, Ambassador of the United Arab Emirates to Austria, and AACC Secretary General Eng. Mouddar Khouja, for a courtesy visit at the premises of the Vienna City Hall. The visit was coordinated by AACC, following a kind request by Ambassador Almusharrakh, who also represented the Arab Ambassadors Council in Austria at this meeting, in his capacity as the Council's current chairperson. AACC Secretary General Khouja underlined the importance of consolidating the relations with the United Arab Emirates and other Arab countries, e.g. Saudi-Arabia and Egypt among others, mainly in the fields of renewable energy, energy-towaste, solar energy, Hydrogen as energy carrier, and waste recycling and management. SG Khouja also presented a special proposal on a research fund for virology, sponsored by HE Mohammed Bin Issa Al-Jaber, one of the most influential businessmen and investors of Arab origin in Austria, and a member of the Board of Directors of AACC.

8 April 2021: AACC- CROWE UAE joint Webinar

On 8 April 2021, AACC held the webinar "United Arab Emirates & Qatar: New Opportunities and considerations for Multinational Companies", jointly organised with Crowe UAE.



AACC Secretary General Eng. Mouddar Khouja presented an overview of the historic, economic and trade relations among the Gulf Cooperation Council States prior to 2017, the demographic and economic characteristics pertaining to each of the UAE and Qatar and to the bilateral trade relations between the two neighbouring countries, in addition to the reconciliation meeting which resulted signing the Al-Ula Declaration by the GCC countries and Egypt early January 2021, and a business outlook and mutual economic benefits of reviving the GCC ties. SG Khouja also highlighted the role that two major upcoming events, namely the FIFA World Cup 2022 in Qatar and Expo Dubai 2020 in the UAE, shall play in accelerating tourism not only within each of the two countries, but also between the two countries and among the GCC countries.

6 April 2021: Austria/ Qatar

On 6 April 2021, AACC Secretary General Eng. Mouddar Khouja paid a courtesy visit to H.E. Ambassador Sultan Salmeen Almansouri, Ambassador Plenipotentiary & Extraordinary and Permanent Representative of the State of Qatar to Austria, joined by Mr. Ahmad Al-Haj, Second Secretary, at the premises of the Qatari Embassy in Vienna. The two discussed various means of strengthening bilateral cooperation between Austria and Qatar, particularly with respect to projects of the State of Qatar in Austria.
